

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Economics and Fin Lit

- Teachers use the FoolProof online digital Modules 1-18 in their Economics and Fin Lit class
- Students successfully complete all modules
- Students pass all modules exams with the Florida state passing score
- Students meet the Fin Lit graduation requirement for Florida



AP or IB Economics

- AP or IB teachers assign FoolProof modules 1-18 as a summer project or early fall project
- Students work through the FoolProof modules 1-18 at their own pace
- Students complete all modules and pass all module test
- Students meet the Fin Lit graduation requirement for Florida



Dual Enrollment Students

- Students who are not taking Economics and Fin Lit or AP or IB Economics on your campus
- They still have to meet the Economic and Fin Lit Florida graduation requirement
- Students take the Economics class at the local college
- Guidance counselors set up these students as a FoolProof class
- They do the FoolProof modules at their own pace and when completed and passed they meet the Fin Lit graduation requirement



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Florida Pre and Post test data

- Pre and module test data all Florida schools + 37.5%
- Pre and module test data from school districts using FoolProof completing and passing all 16 module exams
- Data from 2018/19 school year

How do you prove your student met the Fin Lit graduation requirement?

- School district data, state education department graduation requirement and NCAA
- FoolProof can prove it!
- Standards checked off with completed modules and passed tests
- Test scores and standards met on student transcript
- Data portal for your school district to check all schools progress and completion
